RANGE RULES

- New visitors to the range must complete our **Customer Information, Firearms/Archery Experience & Range Safety form (Easton, PA) or Customer Information Form, Archery Experience & Range Safety Form (Branchburg, NJ)**.
- Only authorized archers are permitted to use the archery ranges to be determined through a brief evaluation by a Heritage Guild staff member.
- The Heritage Guild, at its discretion, may take any and all necessary action to assure the safe operation and use of its facilities.
- Heritage Guild Archery Placards must be visible and worn on one's person at all times while on the range.
- Permitted Equipment: Longbow, Recurve or Compound bow. Full size Crossbow with minimum draw weight of 75 pounds. (Pistol style crossbow is not permitted). The Heritage Guild reserves the right and has final decision on what may be permitted on the range.
- Only Target/Field Points are allowed. No fixed/mechanical or hunting style broadheads allowed! **Use of broadheads will result in a \$500.00 fine.**
- Personal equipment must be inspected by the individual and maintained for safe operation.
- No firearms or hunting allowed.
- No more than six (6) arrows/bolts (one end) will be shot at each relay.
- Relay time not to exceed 10 minutes.
- All shooting will be from the marked firing line only.
- Only straight in-lane shooting is permitted. No crossing shots, roving or clout.
- When a **"Cease Fire"** is called, all arrows/bolts are to be removed from the bows and all bows are to be placed safely on a bow rack. Crossbows must have arrow/bolt removed and the safety engaged.
- Once all bows are secured on a bow rack (crossbows not cocked and unloaded) and the firing line is declared **"Clear"**, archers may enter the range to retrieve their arrows/bolts downrange.
- When the firing line is declared **"Hot"**, archers may retrieve their bows from the bow rack, approach the firing line, nock arrows/bolts and resume.
- The Heritage Guild reserves the right to revoke usage rights to any individual who does not comply with the Archery Range Rules.
- One **MUST** complete **The Heritage Guild Beginner Crossbow Course** to use a crossbow on our ranges. No exceptions.
- **Do not move or attempt to move any of Heritage Guild's 3D targets. If 3D targets are moved and damaged, the customer will be held responsible for the payment of the 3D target.**
- **Heritage Guild's outdoor archery range can only be used during store hours. There will be a \$500.00 fine for anyone not following this rule. Surveillance system in use.**
